statement, but it is not required of the Treasurer.

We also discussed some of the following:

1. A budget, in spreadsheet form, was created pulling amounts from the area policy and

subcommittee policies. We made a few changes and should have a final copy

available next month.

2. We started to discuss the literature budget, but would like to include the literature

chair and treasurer. It was brought up that while we are focused on replenishing

inventory, we are not considering spending less than what area brings in on a given

month. For example, area brings in \$500 literature expenses should not exceed that

amount. We discussed solutions which included trying to find out what is working in

other areas.
