Otherwise will have to get the literature from the Service Center.

**Policy:** Bryan reporting. Met at Freedom church in Hickory. Roberts Rules of Order were discussed. We follow the Guide to Local Service. Discussed tabling the motion. Removing from the table: "I move to remove the table" to bring it back to the floor. Chart on p. 111 gives a good visual of how this works. In regard to the motion for the Convention: Length of time for donation, how long until they get "on their feet". Will need a housecleaning item to remove phoneline monthly expense since it is now covered on a regional level. RCM/RCM2 traveling to MARLCNA was discussed. Paying for more zonal forums now as well. Please see the attached report for more information. Next meeting is 4/26 @ 6pm.

Approval of last month's minutes: March's minutes were approved

<u>Sharing Session</u>: What specifically does Region do for the Susquehanna area? What are the benefits to donating to the Region? Phoneline is supported at the Regional level, Region does for the Areas as Area does for the groups. Our delegates to the World Service Conference comes from the Region.

What is the policy on how they can contribute money to the Area (straight to the Area vs. Special Events subcommittee, etc.)? Home groups can contribute to whoever they wish to donate to. The Group is the highest level and is in control of how they donate their money. SE policy needs to be reviewed given the latest changes with their account and consequences regarding the minimum and maximum values within the account. 



Report: \_The Policy Subcommittee met on 03.22.2019 at the Freedom Church in Hickory. For now, we all agreed to move the subcommittee meeting to 6pm on the 4<sup>th</sup> Friday of the month. The location will remain the same.

We discussed the following:

Roberts Rules of Order and the process of tabling motions. We found that the area policy states the following: "Robert's Rules of Order" adopted by the SASC, provides the basis for procedure that is not otherwise detailed in these guidelines. (A Guide to Local Service pgs. 107 – 114)". We agreed that the proper flow would be the area policy, a guide to local service, then Roberts Rules of Order. Please see the "Guide to Local Services" page 106 and 107, Items 3 and 4 which describe tabling a motion.

There is a chart in the back on page 111 that is helpful to understand how to proceed . once a motion to table has been made.

- 2. The tabled motion: "Half of Regional donation go to FRCNA until convention board gets on its feet." The following suggestions were made:
  - Include parameters for the length of time we are making a donation.
  - Establish a criteria for determining "on its feet"
  - The second concept which states: "The final responsibility and authority for NA services rests with the NA groups". Please read the entire concept.
  - The ninth concept which states: "All elements of our service structure have the responsibility to carefully consider all viewpoints in their decisionmaking process." Please read the entire concept.
  - The eleventh concept which states: "NA funds are to be used to further our primary purpose, and must be managed responsibly."
  - What impact would ½ of all the areas donations to the convention have on the Region itself?
- 3. We discussed the budget and various items identified:
  - It was brought up that we are no longer making a phoneline donation. If so, we can remove that item from our policy.
  - What about the phone line training materials?
  - We need to establish the RCM expenses. As of now we have the travel reimbursement in the policy. The only item that is unclear is related to MARLCNA. The policy states: "The RCM will be reimbursed for attending

MARLCNA annually; travel expenses, entrance fees, and lodging for one night." This leads to question the expenses of the RCMII as well as expenses to the zonal forums that have evolved.

Our next meeting will be held on 04.26.2019 at 6pm. We included reviewing the PR

Guidelines on our Agenda.


