

Report: _____We met last month on May 24th at 6pm. Peggy from Special Events joined us to discuss the Special Events Policy. We evaluated last months motion related to accountability and clarified what was actually being requested. An accounting measure to track Home Group donations. In addition we discussed the following items related to Special Events:

- 1. Prudent Reserve as it relates to special events as their policy currently states anything over \$550 is to be donated back to Area.
- 2. The use of a Facebook page to promote activities. We suggested reviewing the Social Media IP for guidance.
- 3. Use of an accountability statement. The current Special Events policy states: Any person selling tickets, handling money or assets of the SASE must sign an accountability statement."

The policy committee discussed options for keeping the policies current on the website. We are still discussing these options. Another method is to create an Archives on the website as a place to keep older policies as they are changed.


