### Old Motions

We voted against the motion as was the conscience of the ASC. Motions of this nature may be recurring. We can decide if we would like to create a motion of a \$2,500 minimum or simply continue to just vote against any other motion that doesn't reach that minimum.

Motion from Westside Area for the region to purchase Zoom Meetings. This motion passed by a vote of 7 for, 0 against, and 2 abstentions. We voted for this motion. The Zoom meetings will cost \$14.99 a month. It will have a 24 hour meeting limit and max of 100 participants.

### New Motions

The RD and RD II have requested to go a CAR report workshop hosted by the Northern New England Service Committee. They would like to attend as they would get information on the CAR report several months earlier than waiting on the workshop at the MARLCNA. This will allow them to begin facilitating regional and area workshops on the CAR report earlier. The current expense for this will be \$900 dollars, but could change due to the changing cost of airfare and hotels. This motion was tabled until the September Off-Month RSC.

The next RSC will be the off month meeting on September 14 at the Service Center in Baltimore.

The next On-Month RSC will be October 12, remember **ALL SUBCOMMITTEE CHAIRS ARE TO ATTEND THE ON-MONTH RSC**. Subcommittees meet at 10am and the RSC begins at 11:30am.
